In our summer workshop this year we will study a lesson from our new Book 5 textbook: creating a free-style arrangement in a Nageire container of any shape using a “Jumonji-dome” fixture. Carol Walz and Keiko Kubo will show various fixtures for irregular shaped vessels, and make dynamic, horizontally extended compositions that take advantage of the opportunity given by this fixing method. **Please note:** This workshop is open only to students of SHIHAN rank (teachers grade), or those who have certified in books 1, 2, 3 & 4.

WHAT TO BRING: Nageire container of your choice: The vase you bring must be strong to withstand the force applied to it. Glass containers, thin ceramics, or valuable vases are not suitable for this fixing method. It is preferred that you bring an IRREGULAR SHAPED nageire rather than round or square. Bring hasami, mizugiri bowl etc.

COST: \$45 includes fixture, flower & line materials. Light refreshments provided.
